Graphical abstract guidelines

The participants have to provide a graphical abstract, using symbolic representation focusing on the aims and scope of their work. The dimensions of the graphical abstract should be 1920 × 1080 pixels (width × height, landscape orientation, PNG or JPEG). The image should be provided as a separate file during application and incorporated in the title slide of the final presentation. The graphical abstracts will be published in the official Meeting Abstract Book and EUFEPS social media.

By applying, candidates grant permission to publish the submitted graphical abstracts in the official Meeting Abstract Book and EUFEPS social media, as well as confirm that all elements of the graphical abstract are original or used with appropriate permissions and that no confidential unpublished data are disclosed.

Competition guidelines

The participants will have 5 min to present their work. The timing of the presentation will be monitored. Each participant will then receive one question about their research from the judging committee for the discussion (2 min).

The jury will decide on three winners based on the presentation (quality of the slides and the graphical abstract, clarity, timing), originality of the research (application of novel methodologies, impact of the results), and quality of the discussion (successful communication of the overarching goals and contextualisation of the research).
